

VACCINES FOR LIFE PROGRAM

How it works:


- 🐾 Just one low cost payment covers all core vaccines for your pet **FOR LIFE.**
- 🐾 A yearly physical exam is required.
- 🐾 Program is for adult dogs and cats over one year of age.

Why do you need to vaccinate your pet?

- 🐾 Vaccinating your pet yearly will protect them from deadly bacterial and viral diseases that they encounter every day. A lot of these diseases are **ZOONOTIC**- meaning they can be transmitted to humans (you!) Vaccinating your pet keeps them and your family healthy.

What is the financial advantage to the program?

- 🐾 Vaccinating your pet each year can cost \$80 – \$120. With the lifetime vaccination program you pay one low fee of \$99 and never have to pay for vaccines for the rest of your pet's life. This can save you hundreds of dollars.
- 🐾 Example: Fluffy is a 13 month old male Labrador. On average, Labradors live up to 12 years. Vaccines and an exam each year would cost Fluffy's owners \$110, resulting in \$1,210 for the next 11 years. Instead, Fluffy's owners sign up for the Lifetime Vaccine Program. They pay \$99 for lifetime vaccines one time, and \$35 office visits each year. They pay \$484, saving them \$726.



Frequently Asked Questions...

1. Do I get my money back if my pet dies, I surrender him, or I move to another city/state?
 - a. No. The \$99 fee is a one-time, non-fundable charge for joining the Vaccines for Life program.
2. What vaccines are included in the program?
 - a. Canine vaccines: Distemper/Parvovirus combo, Bordetella, Leptospirosis, and Rabies.
 - b. Feline vaccines: Feline Distemper combo and Rabies
3. How many pets can I sign up for the Vaccines for Life program?
 - a. You can sign up as many pets as you like. The \$99 fee applies for each pet. For example: 4 pets = 4 x \$99 = \$396
4. Will my pets be vaccinated every year during their yearly exam?
 - a. It depends on your pet's lifestyle/age. Some vaccines may protect your pet for 3 years, and therefore will not be done on a yearly basis. Other vaccines may require a booster each year. The veterinarian will discuss your pet's needs during the exam.
5. How much does it cost for my once yearly exam?
 - a. \$35*
6. If my pet needs any other services, are there any discounts?
 - a. The Vaccines for Life program only applies to vaccines. There are no additional discounts on other services or products. Ask your veterinarian or veterinary technician for the seasonal promotions that may apply to products such as Heartgard, Frontline, or Sentinel.
7. What if I miss my appointment next year?
 - a. We will call to remind you of the appointment beforehand, and call to remind you that day if you miss the appointment. We allow a 30 day grace period to remain enrolled in the Vaccines for Life program. If an appointment is not fulfilled within the 30 day grace period, re-enrollment with a \$99 fee will be due to enter back into the program.
